TKS Consignor Q & A

- What is my consignor number and where do I find it?
 - Your consignor number is emailed to you immediately after registration. Keep this email – you will use your consignor number to log into My Sale Manager (MSM), our consignor portal.
- When can I start tagging my items?
 - Once the current sale season is open, you may start tagging immediately.
 - Your MSM portal is ready to use as soon as you register.
 - We recommend tagging early to avoid last-minute stress.
- Where can I learn how to consign?
 - You can learn easily by using:
 - TKS Consignors Private Chit Chat Facebook Group (fast answers, photos, videos)
 - Terikidzconsignment.com → Consign Tab (instructions, tagging guides, supply list, standards)

★ ITEM LIMITS

- How many total hanging clothing items can I bring?
 - 300 hanging clothing items per consignor
 - Mega Consignors have no hanging limit
 - Infant hanging (0–18 mo): max 50 items
 - Does not include Specialty & Holiday Sections (Infant only)
 - Juniors: 25 items (true Juniors only– NO WOMENS)
 - Young Men: 25 items
 - Women's Boutique: 30 high-end brands only
- Who qualifies as a Mega Consignor?
 - Mega Consignors are consignors who earned \$500 or more at the previous sale (amount earned, not total sold).
 - Mega Consignors are not limited to 300 hanging items
- How many infant hanging clothing items (0–18 months) can I bring?
 - You may bring up to 50 hanging infant items.
 - This does NOT include:
 - Swaddle wraps
 - Seasonal/Holiday specialty items
- How many Juniors items can I bring?
 - You may bring 20–25 Juniors hanging items.
 - Only true Juniors styles are accepted.
 - Women's clothing may NOT be placed in Juniors.
- How many Young Men's items can I bring?
 - You may bring 20–25 Young Men's hanging items.
 - Styles must be appropriate for teen/young adult males

- What is accepted in the Women's Boutique category?
 - Only higher-end boutique brands are accepted.
 - This category is small and intended for high-quality items only.
 - Do NOT place non-boutique women's clothing in Juniors.

TKS's primary market is Kids Everything, Not Women's Clothing, so we accept VERY LIMITED Women's new and pre-loved boutique and higher-end brand items (purchased within the last 3–4 years) from Petite to Plus Size. ★ ACCEPTED ITEMS

- What clothing sizes does TKS accept?
 - Sizes Infant-18, Juniors, Young Men, Maternity, and Women's Boutique.
 - What shoes does TKS accept?
 - We accept:
 - Kid-appropriate shoes (all sizes)
 - Juniors & Young Men shoes
 - Women's Boutique shoes
- *Shoes must be clean, secured together, and zip-tied.*
- What clothing sizes does TKS accept?
 - Sizes Infant-18, Juniors, Young Men, Maternity, and Women's Boutique.
 - What non-clothing items are accepted?
 - We accept most kid-appropriate items, including:
 - Toys
 - Books
 - Puzzles, games, crafts
 - Sports equipment
 - Outdoor toys
 - Infant gear
 - Furniture
 - Decor
 - Electronics
 - What seasonal items are accepted?
 - Spring/Summer sale: Easter, Patriotic, Swim, Rain Jackets
 - Fall/Winter sale: Christmas, Thanksgiving, Halloween, Snow & Coats

✗ UNACCEPTED ITEMS

- What items cannot be sold at TKS?
 - TKS does NOT accept:
 - Play clothing
 - Breast pumps
 - Stuffed animals (unless interactive)
 - Diaper pails
 - Used crib mattresses (unless on a crib/toddler bed)
 - Mature-rated media
 - VHS, cassettes, PC games Parenting books
 - Non-boutique women's clothing
 - Destination shirts
 - Thirty-One (unless kids related)
 - Adult jewelry (except boutique)
 - Freebie items such as: • Hospital diaper bags• Fast-food toys• Sample formula
- We do NOT accept used:
 - Pacifiers
 - Bottle nipples
 - Underwear
 - Socks

*Only sealed, new-in-package versions are accepted.

★ PREPARING ITEMS

- What condition do items need to be in?
 - All items must be:
 - Like-new
 - Clean
 - Odor-free
 - Organized
 - No stains, rips, or damage
 - No missing parts
 - No recalls
- *Everything is inspected. Bring your BEST!
- How should I prepare clothing?
 - All clothing must be on hangers
 - Hanger hook should face like a "?"
 - Wire/metal hangers preferred
 - Secure bottoms with zip ties
 - Group items by gender → size → category
 - Shake-test every item
- Mooresville Fall Sale only: NO Thick plastic/tube hangers
- Can I bundle items to make outfits?
 - Yes
 - Clothing- You may bundle same-size items or create outfits on one hanger.
 - Other Items- You may bundle items, always ask yourself
 - Would I want to buy these items together?
- How should I prepare shoes?
 - Clean thoroughly
 - Zip-tie together
 - Place by gender and size at drop-off
 - Infant booties may be in baggies
- How should I prepare toys, baby gear, and large items?
 - Include manuals, instructions, and original retail value
 - All items requiring power must have WORKING batteries
 - Bundle multi-piece sets
 - Large items must be fully assembled at drop-off

★ PRICING

- What is the minimum price?
 - \$2.00, in increments of \$0.50.
- Should I allow discounting?
 - YES – highly recommended for best sell-through.
- Should I allow donation?
 - We always suggest donating your items after the sale!
 - If you choose donation, unsold items are reduced to 75% off after the 50% sale and donated to support the local community.
 - The "Smile & Go" drop-off option is available to donation consignors.

★ Tagging

- What are the tagging rules?
 - Tags must go through a SEAM, never through fabric
 - Use white 65 lb cardstock
 - Attach to top-right of clothing or right armpit
 - Zip-tie shoes
 - Do NOT tape over the barcode
 - THIS INCLUDES CLEAR TAPE

★ DROP-OFF APPOINTMENTS

- Do I need a drop-off appointment?
 - Most consignors will need a drop-off appointment.
 - Your requirements depend on whether you have a helper shift and when that shift occurs:
 - Consignor ONLY (no helper shift):
 - You must schedule a drop-off appointment in MSM.
 - Helper Shift BEFORE 12PM Thursday (Presale Helper):
 - 300 items or less:
 - Arrive 30 minutes early or stay after your shift to drop off
 - Over 300 items:
 - You must schedule a drop-off appointment
 - Helper Shift AFTER 12PM Thursday:
 - You must schedule a drop-off appointment.
- What is "Smile & Go" Drop-Off?
 - If you donate 100% of your unsold items:
 - Stay in your car
 - HONK
 - TKS Helpers unload your vehicle
 - You receive your shopping pass
 - Fastest drop-off option!

★ DROP-OFF PREP

- How should I organize my hanging clothing for drop-off?
 - Organize by:
 - Gender
 - Size
 - Category (Boutique, Pajamas, Seasonal, Dance, Sports, etc.)
- How should I organize bin/loose items?
 - Group items by category such as:
 - Toys • Puzzles & games • Outdoor • Room décor • Sporting goods
 - Crafts • Infant • Electronics • Holiday • Infant toys
- Do large items need assembly?
 - YES – all large items must be fully assembled at drop-off.
 - A "Large Item Tag" must also be filled out.
- Do I need to leave a bin for unsold items?
 - If you are not donating everything:
 - ✓ Leave a plastic bin labeled with your consignor number on all 4 sides.
 - If no bin is left, a \$5 fee will be deducted.

★ EARNINGS & HELPER SHIFTS

- How much do consignors earn?
 - 60% – consignor only
 - 65% – +4 hours
 - 67% – +8 hours
 - 70% – +12 hours (must include setup or sort)
 - 72% – +16 hours (must include sort)
 - 75% – +20 hours (must include sort)

*Helpers always shop FIRST.

- What do helpers do?
 - Helpers may assist with:
 - Setup
 - Drop-off
 - Inspections
 - Organizing racks and tables
 - Helping shoppers
 - Sorting
 - Breakdown
 - Meal/snack shifts

*There is a spot for everyone!

★ Same Number Consignor:

- Can I consign at both locations?
 - YES – you can consign at Mooresville and Salisbury with:
 - ✓ No extra work
 - ✓ No re-tagging
 - ✓ Two chances to sell your items

★ DEADLINES

- When does drop-off and helper scheduling close?
 - The Friday before Set-Up at NOON.
- When does the tagging system close?
 - The tagging system closes Wednesday of drop-off week at NOON.
 - (You may still print tags after the system closes.)
